## Pedestrian Struck and Fatally Injured in Gurnee Accident

**Gurnee** – On November 6, 2023, shortly after 9:00 PM, Gurnee Police responded to the area of Hunt Club Road and Washington Street for an accident involving a pedestrian.

During the initial investigation, officers learned a female was crossing Hunt Club Road, approximately 100 feet north of the crosswalk along Washington Street. The pedestrian, identified as a 56-year-old female from Round Lake Beach, was wearing all black clothing while walking northbound in the left lane of Hunt Club Road. A Buick Encore, driven by a 24-year-old male from Kenosha, Wisconsin, was traveling northbound on Hunt Club Road and struck the pedestrian. The collision resulted in the pedestrian being propelled into the right lane of northbound Hunt Club Road.

Moments later, a second vehicle, a Honda Civic, driven by a 19-year-old female of Wauconda, was traveling northbound in the left lane of Hunt Club Road. The Honda went around the stopped Buick and struck the female, who was lying in the roadway.

The pedestrian was transported to Advocate Condell Medical Center in Libertyville with serious injuries. She was later pronounced deceased at the hospital.

No other injuries were reported from the accident.

Investigators with the Major Crash Assistance Team (MCAT) responded to the scene and aided with the crash investigation. Hunt Club Road was closed in both directions during the investigation.

This crash remains under investigation by the Gurnee Police Department.
