Gurnee Police Investigate Deceased Male Found at Neighborhood Intersection

Gurnee – On Monday morning at approximately 3:39 AM, the Gurnee Police Department received a report of an unresponsive male lying in the street at the intersection of Dorchester Avenue and Estes Street. Responding officers discovered the male, who appeared to have been dragged by a vehicle.

Preliminary investigations suggest that the deceased was a resident of the 3800 block of Dorchester Avenue. He went outside to smoke and was last seen by his wife around 3:00 AM. She reported that he had gone outside for a smoke, after which she lost contact with him.

Our officers are diligently working to gather information and evidence to determine the circumstances surrounding this tragic incident. At this stage, we are treating this as an active investigation. We urge anyone with relevant information to come forward and assist us in our efforts.

The Gurnee Police Department reminds citizens the information submitted to Crime Stoppers is completely anonymous. Crime Stoppers does not utilize caller ID, and conversations are not recorded.
