Illinois EPA

- Creature of statute
- Statutory mission to safeguard environmental quality to protect health
- Primary tools:
 - Permitting
 - Regulations
 - Enforcement

Ethylene Oxide Timeline

- USEPA reclassification
- Federal approach assess, rule review
- Illinois Willowbrook
- IEPA outreach to EtO sources

Medline Industries

- Pushed for emission reductions
- Required new controls/measures modeled to ensure reduced risk
- Measures formed technical basis for Matt Haller Act
- Most restrictive requirements in country

Medline Industries

- Permanent total enclosure
- New controls (scrubber, dry bed absorbtion)
- Back vent controls
- Improved control of emissions
- Common stack
- Annual limit of 150 pounds
- Continuous emissions monitoring

Vantage Specialty Chemicals

- Pushed for emission reductions
- Achieved through enhanced controls
- Modeling being performed
- Permit transactions to follow
