# **CAD System**

Update on Lake County Joint CAD/RMS/JMS RFP Lake County Emergency Telephone System Board – Special Call Meeting – Apr 30, 2021

Tyler is the proposed vendor. This moved through a negotiation process. This is currently going through some Lake County Board Committees and then to a full Board Meeting in May. The current proposed model of this is the Lake County Sheriffs Office and Lake County ETSB would shoulder the majority of the costs for licensing and implementation and all participating agencies would be responsible for maintenance costs, data conversion and training. This creates a lower cost opportunity for add on agencies and a improves interoperability. Some discussion was made about what maintenance costs would be picked up by this board. Chairman Velkover advised it would remain the same as it is now where CAD maintenance costs would be covered by the board. Anything RMS or JMS related would be covered by the respective individual agencies.

#### **Radio Systems**

Consolidated Fire Radio System Implementation

Troy highlighted the go live date of April 6<sup>th</sup>, and advised everything went amazingly well. There are some minor tweaks identified but nothing major.

Motorola Proposal - Console and Core upgrade

Motorola provided a Starcom upgrade proposal, which is included in the packet. This would move the connection from an independent connection to a centralized conection, updated all dispatch radio positions, change in the recorder interface, allow console priority for Starcom channels and requires a recurring cost for a leased line.

#### **Facilities**

Gurnee PD/Communications UPS Supplemental Battery Modules

Battery modules were added to the existing B-side UPS cabinet, increasing the estimated run time from 80 to 106 minutes. This was a good cost/value proposition. The A-side UPS run time is estimated at 128 minutes.

Gurnee PD/Communications Rooftop HVAC Compressor Replacement

Chairman Velkover thanked Support Services Director Petersen for getting the last of 3 rooftop compressors, which were original to the building, replaced. This supports the Liebert HVACE units for the Communications Center and equipment room HVAC.

Regional 911 Operations Committee Agenda May 3, 2021

Overview of the selected CAD, Mobile, RMS, JMS, E-Citations and E-Crash Software was discussed. All the contributed funds for the group have been expended. Additional cost have been covered by Lake County.

Details on rule proposals for allowable expenses. Highlighted was "Equipment or infrastructure for law enforcement, firefighters, and other public safety/first responder entities, including public safety radio equipment and infrastructure, that does not have a direct impact on the ability of a PSAP to receive or respond to 911 calls or to dispatch emergency responders."
