Southridge, Rolling Ridge, and Fairway Ridge had their most recent neighborhood watch meeting on 10/02/19. The meeting was facilitated by Officers Yencich and Lambert.

Police Activity Summary (Southridge):

There were 172 police calls for service and 5 of the calls for service were for actual crimes. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service related.

Police Activity Summary (Rolling Ridge and Fairway Ridge):

There were 400 police calls for service generated and 9 of the calls for service were for actual crimes. The rest of the calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service related.

Crime Prevention:

Officers Yencich and Lambert led a discussion about the cannabis law that will go into effect on January 1, 2020 and the impact it may have in our Village. The Village Board is also considering the option to allow a recreational dispensary in town, based on the guidelines of the new law. Residents were encouraged to visit the Village of Gurnee website to take a short survey to express their opinion on the topic.
