Chittenden Park and Brown Circle areas had their neighborhood watch meeting on 10/09/19. The meeting was led by Officers Woodruff and Butur.

Police Activity Summary for Single-family Home Area of Brown Circle (west of Delany Rd.):

There were 23 police calls for service in the Brown Circle neighborhood during January 1 - June 30, 2019. 1 of the calls for service was for an actual crime. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service-related.

Police Activity Summary for Chittenden Park (east of Delany Rd.):

835 police calls for service were recorded in Chittenden Park neighborhood during the first half of 2019. 20 of the calls for service were for actual crimes. The rest of the police calls are considered quasi-criminal, traffic, and service-related.

Crime Prevention:

Officers Woodruff and Butur led a discussion about the cannabis law that will go into effect on January 1, 2020 and the impact it may have in our Village. The Village Board is also considering the option to allow a recreational dispensary in town, based on the guidelines of the new law. Residents were notified that the Village of Gurnee would be sending a short survey on October 9th via the Connect CTY alert system.
