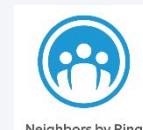

Updates from the police department, crime prevention tips, press releases, and upcoming events are posted regularly



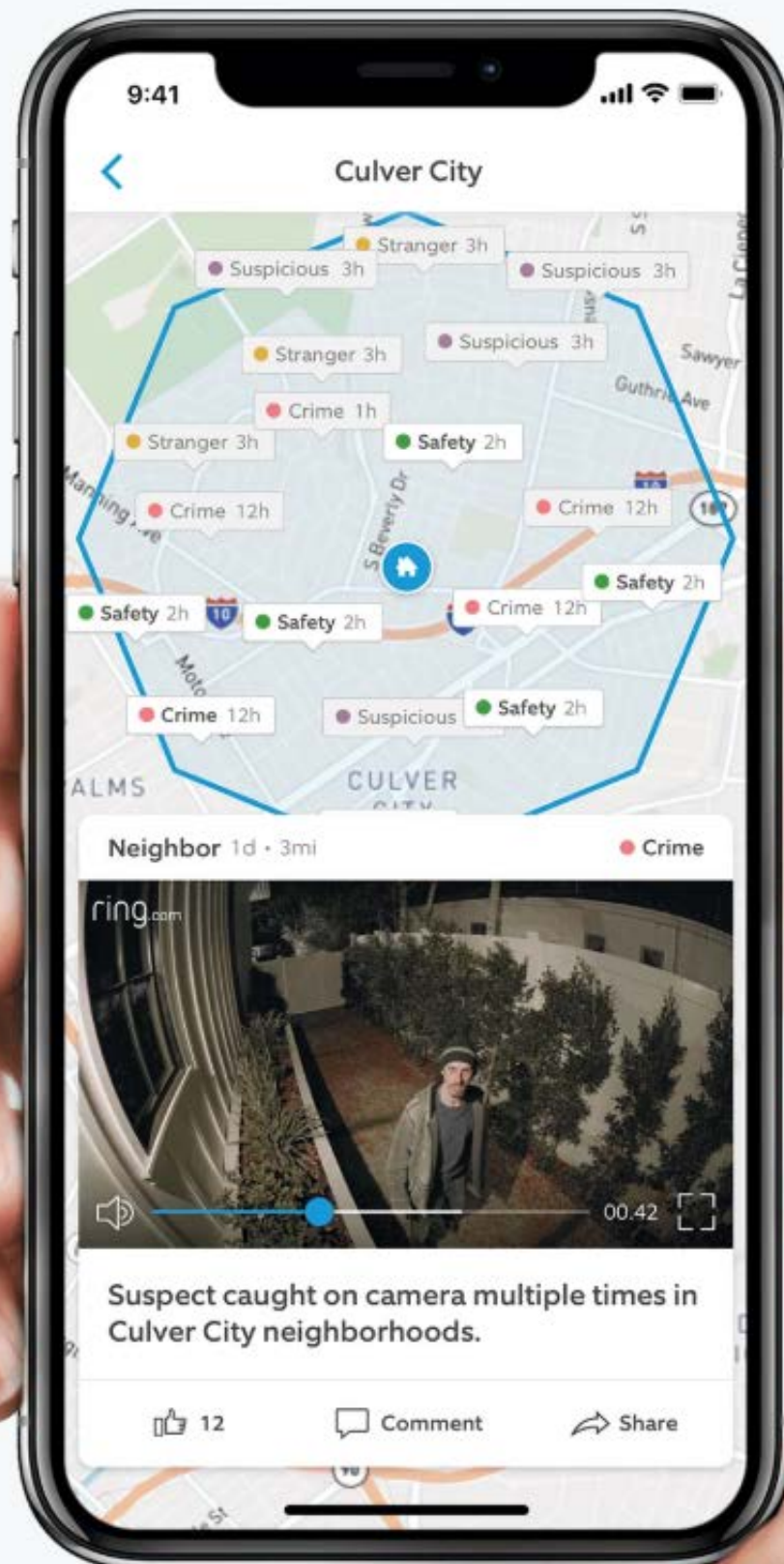

CRIME PREVENTION EVOLVES WITH TECHNOLOGY

- Communication app for crime and safety only
- Free for all users
- Do NOT need to own a Ring device
- Sends you alerts based on a radius around your home
- Share alerts with neighbors
- Share photos or videos of suspicious activity
- Gurnee Police can send notifications about recent crime
- Can share videos with Gurnee Police for investigation



Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR)

Gathered to generate reliable statistical information about crime in our nation

Information collected by the FBI from over 18,000 cities made up of:

- Federal agencies
- Universities / Colleges
- State Troopers
- County Sheriffs
- Local Police

Information collected provides guidance for crime prevention measures and strategy

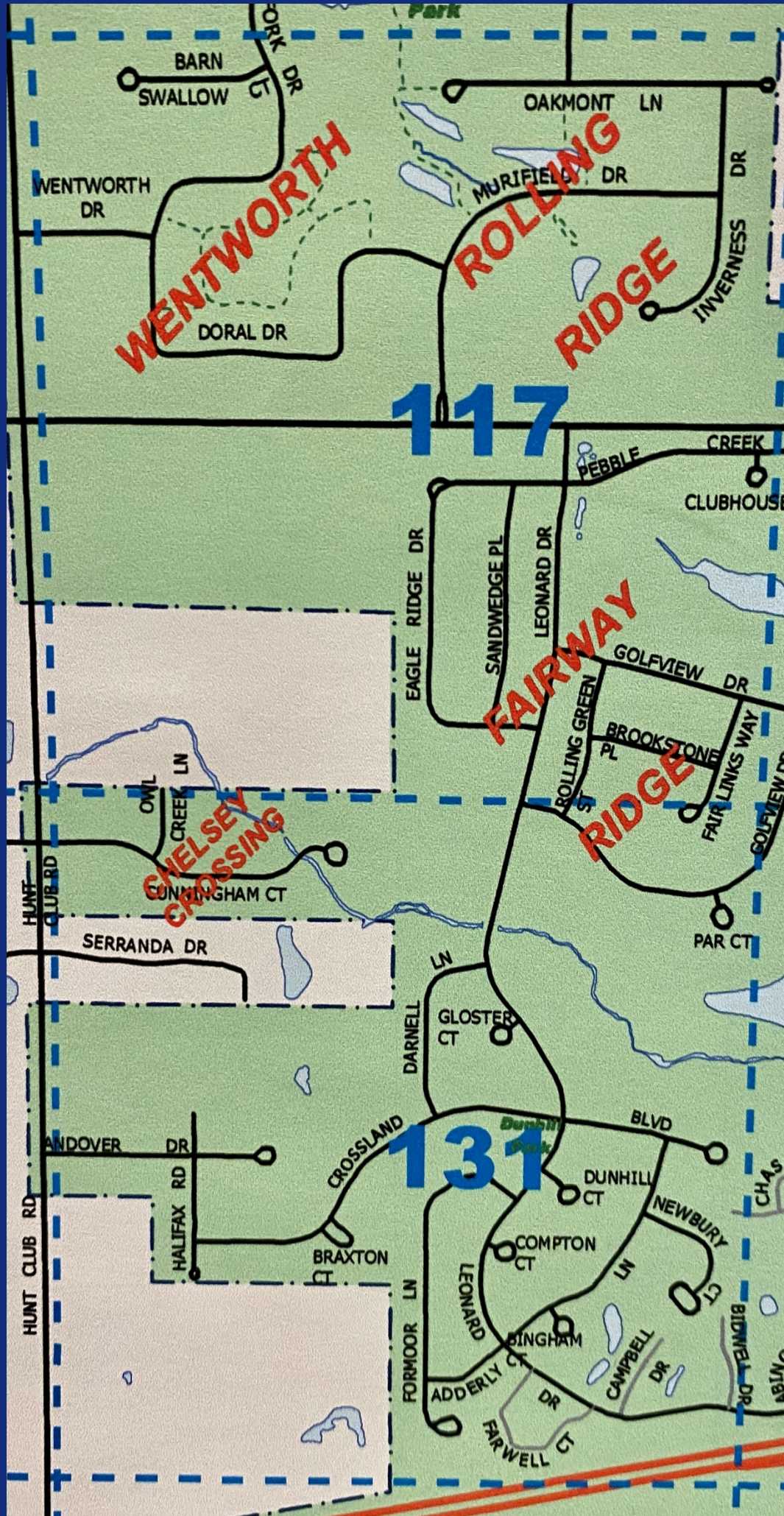

Common Questions From Residents

- 
- Distracted Driving
 - Aggressive Driving
 - Phone Scams

Manual Distractions

Taking your hands off of the wheel to change stations, looking at the navigation system, or manipulating the temperature

Visual Distractions

Looking at an accident scene, glancing at a text message, or focusing on children or pets inside the vehicle

Cognitive Distractions

Daydreaming, contemplating a problem at work or home, or making a mental "to-do" list for the weekend

What are the types of distracted driving?



WAYS TO AVOID DISTRACTED DRIVING

Electronics

Don't look at your phone while driving. Put your cellphone on "Do Not Disturb While Driving"

Family Members

Secure children and pets before driving. If they need attention, pull over to the side of the road

Passengers

Conversations with passengers should be light in topic. Reserve serious discussions for another time

Eating

Life is busy. Schedule meal times either before or after driving, not while driving



CURRENT ILLINOIS LAW

■ NEW LAW AS OF JULY 1, 2019

Drivers caught texting while driving will receive a moving violation.
With 3 or more moving citations (speeding, texting, etc.) your license may be suspended.

■ HAND -HELD DEVICES PROHIBITED

All drivers must be hands free while in a moving vehicle.
Hands-free devices are only allowed for drivers 19 years or older.

■ ELECTRONIC DEVICES ALLOWED

In an emergency situation
When you are pulled over on the side of the road
When your vehicle is in park

Additional Patrols

Officers know the dangers associated with driving distracted. Citations are being issued when violations are witnessed.

Several annual grants are dedicated to distracted driving - April is distracted driving month.

Education

We are spreading the word about the risks of distracted driving and making drivers aware of their driving habits.

We need your help! Educate your family and friends about the dangers of driving distracted.

Aggressive Driving

Operation of a motor vehicle in a manner that endangers or is likely to endanger others or property.

Examples



DON'T ENGAGE THE DRIVER

Do not retaliate. Engaging the driver may escalate the situation

GET OUT OF THE WAY

When safe to do so, move out of the way and allow the driver to pass. Set an example of a safe driver

DON'T UNDERESTIMATE THEIR POTENTIAL

Aggressive drivers often try to engage and intimidate other drivers. Do not make eye contact. Continue to drive safely to your destination.

YOUR OWN ENCOUNTERS

Contact police if you fear you are in danger

HOW CELLPHONE COMPANIES HELP YOU

T-MOBILE

Automatically filters spam calls for subscribers.
Spam calls do not come through to the cellphone user.
Cannot stop all spam calls.

SPRINT & VERIZON

Offers an "Opt -In" version of spam filtering. Subscribers must download an app to avoid receiving spam calls.
Sprint's App - Sprint Call Screener
Verizon's App - Verizon Call Filter

Fraud Blocker was automatically added for subscribers .
