


What Our Neighborhood Watch is Not



Cannabis Regulation Effective 01/01/20 Illinois House Bill 1438

- Signed into law on June 25, 2019
- Legalizes recreational use of cannabis for adults over 21
- Expands current medical licensing system
- Offers expungement for previous cannabis convictions
- Tax collection based on potency of cannabis and the type of product sold









Recreational Use for Illinois Residents

- Must be 21 years of age or older
- Possession limitations
 - 30 grams of cannabis flower
 - 500 milligrams of THC in cannabis infused product
 - 5 grams of cannabis concentrate









Recreational Use for Non-Residents

- Must be 21 years of age or older
- Possession limitations
 - 15 grams of cannabis flower
 - 250 milligrams of THC in cannabis infused product
 - 2.5 grams of cannabis concentrate









Recreational Use – Under 21 years old

- Possession is a civil law violation
- If in a motor vehicle at the time of possession
 - Secretary of State may suspend or revoke driving privileges
 - Parents or guardians who permit consumption by underage persons are subject to a Class A Misdemeanor and fines of at least \$500









Recreational Use

- Purchasing cannabis at dispensing organizations
 - Must show ID to confirm purchaser is 21
 - Anyone under 21 presenting a false ID or using someone else's ID may face:
 - Class A Misdemeanor
 - Driving privileges suspended or revoked









Recreational Possession In Public Spaces

- <u>Possessing</u> cannabis is *NOT* permitted while:
 - In a school bus
 - On any preschool, primary / secondary school grounds

*Persons permitted as a qualifying patient or caregiver for the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act are the exception to these rules.









Recreational Possession In Public Spaces (Cont.)

- <u>Possessing</u> cannabis is *NOT* permitted while:
 - In any correctional facility
 - In a private vehicle, unless:
 - The cannabis is in a reasonably secured, sealed container, and inaccessible while the vehicle is moving
 - In a private residence that is used at any time to provide licensed child care or similar social service care









Recreational Use In Public Spaces

- <u>Using</u> cannabis is *NOT* permitted while:
 - In a school bus
 - On any preschool, primary / secondary school grounds

*Persons permitted as a qualifying patient or caregiver for the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act are the exception to these rules.









Recreational Use In Public Spaces (Cont.)

- <u>Using</u> cannabis is *NOT* permitted while:
 - In any motor vehicle
 - In any public place
 - In a private residence that is used at any time to provide licensed child care or similar social service care
 - In knowingly close physical proximity to anyone under 21 years of age who is not registered as a medical cannabis patient









Recreational Use

- Illinois law does NOT allow any person to engage in:
 - Smoking cannabis in any place where smoking is prohibited
 - Operating, navigating, or being in control of any motor vehicle
 - Giving cannabis to anyone who is not allowed to use cannabis under Illinois law









Recreational Use

- Illinois law does NOT allow any person to engage in:
 - The use of cannabis by law enforcement, corrections officers, or firefighters while on duty
 - The use of cannabis by persons who have a school bus permit or commercial driver's license while on duty









Recreational Use

- Employers can adopt a ZERO tolerance or drug free workplace policy
- Private businesses can restrict or prohibit use of cannabis on its property, such as Six Flags Great America or Gurnee Mills









Cultivating Cannabis for Personal Use

- Illinois resident, 21 years or older:
 - Must be a registered qualifying patient under the Compassionate Use or Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act (Medical Marijuana)
 - Limit of 5 plants, per household
 - Cultivation must be in an enclosed, locked space
 - Plants must be out of ordinary public view
 - No grower or cultivation center license is required









Cannabis Regulation Fund Tax Distribution

- Tax revenue received will be distributed as follows:
 - 35% General Revenue Fund
 - 25% Restore Communities
 - 20% Department of Human Services (Drug Treatment)
 - 10% Budget Stabilization Fund
 - 8% Law Enforcement Local Government Fund
 - 2% Department of Human Services (Education)
